## **Announcing the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Worldwide Ringmaster Fly-A-Thon!! October 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 (aka, the Ringathon!)**

The Fly-A-Thon is honoring the plane that many of us flew back in the 50s, 60s 70s and 80s. Simply stated, we want to see how many Ringmaster flights can be recorded over a single weekend, the first weekend in October. Last year we recorded 8327 flights (a new record!) with 524 pilots in a number of different countries worldwide. The NW Skyraiders managed 67 flights with 8 pilots....busy circles...and we've done better!

The simple rules are stated below. I want to particularly note; NO Builder of the Model requirement!) Recruiting new people to join our control line model airplane hobby is an important aspect of this event! We hope you will join us this year and have fun flying your Ringmasters along with fellow modelers around the world!

### **Rules:**

- Any Ringmaster from 1/2A to Giant and all variants (bipes, twins, etc.) can be flown.
- The goal is maximum number of flights with all pilots and planes participating.
- Fly both days to double your fun....all flights count toward the total.
- A 'flight' is a minimum of 5 laps (in the air !!) to be qualifying.
- No builder of the model rule is in effect for this event!
