

Driving to “Nick’s Field” 22MAY18

From the North (Seattle Area)

Take I-5 South to Olympia – stay in the right lane, turning onto HWYs 8/101 WEST. A few miles later 101 will peel off North bound, but you stay straight West on 8 for 21 miles to Elma. HWY 12 joins HWY 8 and they both proceed West together. Follow 8/12 for 4 miles to Satsop. Turn left (South) on Keyes Road. After about ½ mile, turn left (East) on Wenzel Slough Road. The farmhouse of our host is on your right about ½ mile, and the entrance to the flying field in on your left. Congratulations!

From the South (Oregon and S Washington)

Take I-5 North to Exit# 88, marked Rochester, onto HWY 12 (Old 99) which meanders North and West through a series of small towns: Rochester, Oakville, Malone, until it joins HWY 12 at Elma. in Elma, HWY 12 joins HWY 8 and they both proceed West together. Follow 8/12 for 4 miles to Satsop. Turn left (South) on Keyes Road. After about ½ mile, turn left (East) on Wenzel Slough Road. The farmhouse of our host is on your right about ½ mile, and the entrance to the flying field in on your left. You are there!
